

The Escondido Adobe Home Tour

October 5, 2014 :: 11 AM to 4 PM

The fourth annual Escondido Adobe Home Tour features three residences, a mid-century ranch house, and a suggested finale at *Hacienda Vega* restaurant; originally the model home for the revival of adobe construction in the area.

This year's tour includes three Weir Brothers adobes. Each feature their signature touches, such as rounded walls and use of heavy timbers. The tour includes the lodge at the Bandy Canyon Ranch, once a country retreat of Justine Fenton, widow of ranch owner Henry Fenton. Built in the 1950s and remodeled by the Weir Brothers in the 1970s. The lodge has the signature Weir ceiling featuring original beams from the historic San Diego pier, three patios with outdoor fireplaces and exceptionally lovely gardens.

The self-guided home tour is from 11 to 4, with Bandy Canyon Ranch closing at 2 PM.
