**Hike Overlooking Rancho Guejito**

Come join us for a **five mile** hike on Bureau of Land Management land with views of beautiful Rancho Guejito. The hike will take us up some steep terrain to a ridgeline. You will see wonderful views in all directions and a path that weaves its way through a garden of California native plants. This three-hour hike will be at a moderate pace with some steep but mostly moderate terrain. Trail is often narrow and uneven. Long pants and sun protection recommended.

**Directions to meeting place:**

Meet at Hellhole Canyon Preserve parking lot.  
19324 Santee Lane, Valley Center

From Valley Center, turn onto Woods Valley Road for 3.9 miles. Continue straight onto Paradise Mountain Rd for 3.3 miles. Turn right onto Los Hermanos Ranch Rd/Paradise Mtn Rd and immediately turn left onto Kiavo Rd. Take Kiavo Rd. for .5 miles to Santee Lane and make a left up the preserve entrance.

Heavy rain during 24 hours before hike or steady rain one hour in advance of start time cancels hike. Cancellation will be posted on VCTA FaceBook page
