## **Overlooking Rancho Guejito, From Hellhole Canyon Preserve**

Meet at Hellhole Canyon Preserve parking lot, at Kiavo Dr., in Valley Center. We will hike in the adjacent BLM property. This is a moderate hike with a steep, narrow, overgrown start, followed by gradual ups and downs; plan on 2 - 3 hours.

Rancho Guejito is a parcel of about 22,000 acres, about 13,000 acres of which is one of the last intact original Mexican land grants, made in 1845.
