Ramona Grasslands Hike**

Come join us for a **four mile** hike through the Ramona Grasslands Preserve. The Ramona Grasslands contains a portion of the Santa Maria Creek watershed. The watershed supports a mosaic of habitat types, including native and non-native grasslands, coastal sage and chaparral, oak woodlands, Santa Maria Creek, its adjacent riparian area, and a diversity of unique vernal pools.

Directions to meeting place:

Take the I-15 freeway & exit West Bernardo/Pomerado Road. Go east, then turn left at the signal light at Highland Valley Rd. **Trailhead** and staging area are on Highland Valley Rd., just east of Archie Moore Rd.

Steady rain 24 hours before event cancels hike.

Heavy rain one hour before start time on day of hike cancels.
